



## DRUGS, ALCOHOL, AND TOBACCO USE

### *CSF GetAhead Programs operate on a Tobacco Free Campus*

By utilizing the CVUSD campus', the CSF GetAhead Program is required to enforce a tobacco-free campus policy; to communicate this to school staff, parents, pupils and community; and to post signs stating "Tobacco Use Prohibited" at all entrances to schools.

Information about tobacco is available through bulletins and memos that provide a list of cessation resources. Additionally, under HSC 104495, smoking or use of tobacco-related products and disposal of any tobacco-related waste within 25 feet of a school playground is prohibited, except on a public sidewalk located within 25 feet of the playground. Students shall not possess, smoke, or use tobacco or any product containing tobacco or nicotine while on campus, while attending school-sponsored activities, or while under the supervision and control of district employees. Prohibited products include, but are not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, miniature cigars, clove cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, snuff, chew packets, betel and electronic cigarettes (e-cigarette) and cartridge.
