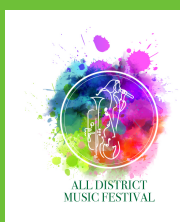
PROCEDURE

All elementary string students must arrive at the Performing Arts Center by 4:15 pm. Transportation will not be provided.

Parents may park in the parking structure located on Dallas Dr. and walk their child to the theater, look for signs directing you where to go. From this point, students will be escorted into the theater for rehearsal and stay at the theatre until after the concert.

The concert will begin at 5pm. Post-concert pick-up will follow the same procedure as post-rehearsal pick-up.
